Extended Hours: \$1,050.00 for full 6-Week Program

At the time of registration, you may pay in full or opt to pay a **\$300.00 deposit** to secure your space. Registration deposits will be applied to your overall summer camp fee. **All fees are due in full by May 29, 2026.**

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

- Starts March 9, Closes April 30
- Scholarships are limited and will be awarded on a needs basis.
- All scholarship applications must include the most recent tax return or employment documentation.
- All scholarship documentation must be delivered to Josue Morales, Membership Director.
- You will be notified if your child is awarded a full or partial scholarship. Parents must sign scholarship agreements to accept any award.

REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION

Registration requires the following forms to enroll your child(ren) in summer camp. No exceptions can be given.

- Complete online application, including payment or deposit.
- A copy of your child's Birth Certificate
- A copy of the Club Health Form
- Medication Authorization Form: If your child will need any medication during camp, the form must be completed and signed by the doctor and parent.
- Medication Action Plan: Any child who requires medication during camp hours must have a written action plan for their child.

ACTIVITIES

Camp includes indoor and outdoor activities, depending on the weather.

Program activities include education and enrichment, STEM, culinary arts, athletics, character and leadership development, swimming, and more special activities every week!
